Matthew 5:8 Blessed (happy) are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.

Matthew 23:27 (NIV) Woe unto you, (Sorrow upon you), teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You are like whitewashed tombs, which look beautiful on the outside but on the inside are full of the bones of the dead and everything unclean.

Matthew 15:8 (NKJV) *“These people draw near to Me with their mouth, And honor Me with their lips, But their heart is far from Me. 9a And in vain they worship Me,*

Ephesians 6:6 *“...but as the servants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart;”*

To be “pure” means “to be cleansed from sin.”

Matthew 6:21 *For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.*

Acts 2:46 *And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart.*

Acts 2:1 *When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. v2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven.*

Matthews 6:24a *No man can serve two masters...*

James 4:4 *You adulterers! Don't you realize that friendship with the world makes you an enemy of God? I say it again: If you want to be a friend of the world, you make yourself an enemy of God.*

v8 *Come close to God, and God will come close to you. Wash your hands, you sinners; purify your hearts, for your loyalty is divided between God and the world.*

Romans 7:19 *For the good that I would I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do.*

v23 *But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members. v24 O wretched man that I am! Who shall deliver me from the body of this death?*

HOW DO I BECOME PURE IN HEART?

Titus 2:14 *Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all sin, and purify to himself a peculiar people, zealous (enthusiastic, passionate) for good works.*

Psalm 15:1 *...LORD, who shall abide in your tabernacle? who shall dwell in your holy hill? v2 He that walks uprightly, and works righteousness, and speaks the truth in his heart.*

Psalm 24:3 *Who shall ascend into the hill of the LORD? or who shall stand in his holy place? v4 He that has clean hands, and a pure heart; who has not lifted up his soul to vanity, nor sworn deceitfully. v5 He shall receive the blessing from the LORD, and righteousness from the God of his salvation.*
